CINEMAROSA -queens only queer film series- will present a selection of shorts produced and directed by local film/video/media artists. Following the screenings, meet with the makers in an open panel and a Q&A session followed by a pink champagne reception at the museum's Unisphere Gallery.

Among the works to be screened are, for the boys:

Wish Fulfillment, dir. Matt Brown & David Simpatico (A wild ride with a very simple premise: a son comes out to his father in 10 possible ingenuous variations); **Mormor's Visit**, dir. Casper Andreas (A Swedish photographer living in Harlem, receives the unexpected visit of his 82 year old grandmother. He has to figure out how to explain the black naked man in his bed...); **Night Swimming**, dir. Daniel Falcone (A teenage punker sets out on a mission with his best friend, to see their favorite band perform in New York City. Once their road trip ends, their real adventure begins!).

For the girls:

Open, dir. Teale Failla (Through intersecting timelines and modern ideas of monogamy, an open relationship turns the lives of three women into a whirlwind of betrayal, bingo, and sexy toys); **Desperate For Love**, dir. Angel Brown (A black lesbian who's been out of the dating scene for quite sometime explores ways to find love in all the wrong places); **Seven Minutes In Heaven**, dir. Emily North (Riding the subway, a young woman creates her own secret version of "heaven." The crowded subway is the pornographic open studio where a young woman lets her imagination flow).
